Providing after-school education, health care and extra-curricular support with a Christian ethic for children living in the surrounding slums so that they might have a chance to move away from a life on the streets where crime is rife. **£20** covers a daily meal, tuition, health check-ups and extra curricular activities for each child at the project for a month.

ICEG, Anapolis, Brazil



ICEG provides a Christian home for orphaned, abandoned or neglected children. **£15** covers one child's daily needs of food, clothing, education and health care each month.

La Fuente, El Tingo, Ecuador



An after-school programme providing education, a daily meal and community activities for local children in this poor, rural village just outside Quito, the capital. **£15** provides a place for one child for a month.

Katwe Community Project, Uganda



ICEG provides a Christian home for orphaned, abandoned or neglected children. **£15** covers one child's daily needs of food, clothing, education and health care each month.

Thika Orphans & Grandparents Scheme, Kenya



Supporting poor grandparents looking after their HIV/AIDs orphaned grandchildren by providing a means of self-sufficiency to pay for rent, food, clothing and school fees for the little ones now under their care. **£20** will enable TOGS to bring such support to these orphaned children each month.

New Hope Children's Centre, Nairobi, Kenya



A Christian home for over 120 orphaned or abandoned children, mainly girls, providing food, clothing and education in a family environment. **£20** will feed, clothe and educate one child in this unique and loving home each month.

Daylove Children's Centre, Nairobi, Kenya



Daylove provides children from local slums with a hot meal, clothes and basic education (or vocational training) to give them hope and help prevent them from roaming the streets for survival. **£20** enables the project to provide this for one child, or a bed at night for the more vulnerable children, each month.
