Gifts purchased from this catalogue will be distributed, where most needed, amongst the following project partners in Ecuador, Kenya and Uganda.

NEW HOPE CHILDREN'S CENTRE

A Christian home in Kenya for over 140 orphaned or abandoned children, providing food, clothing and education.

DAYLOVE CHILDREN'S CENTRE

A children's day centre and night shelter in the Dagoretti slum of Nairobi, Kenya providing education and a daily meal.

MANO Y MANO

An after-school education and welfare support programme for children living in the impoverished community of El Tingo, Ecuador.

GFI-MOGONJET SCHOOL

A rural school in western Kenya where most parents are subsistence farmers so have little money for fees etc.

NSAMBYA COMMUNITY PROJECT

A school and clinic in the Katwe Slum in Kampala, Uganda providing support for the children and families who live there.

NSHUMI SCHOOL

A rural school in Nshumi, Western Uganda struggling to provide a good education for local children.

NAMRATA SHAH ORPHANAGE

An orphanage in Thika, Kenya, providing a home and education for the 34 children who live there.

TOGS

Helping aged grandparents in Thika, Kenya, to look after their orphaned grandchildren through self-sufficiency support.

All too often elderly grandparents are left to care for their grandchildren after the death of their own children, in Kenya. With no state support, these vulnerable people need enterprising solutions to keep their families together and healthy.
